The classes are at 8:00 pm the Considine Center (Room 1-6)

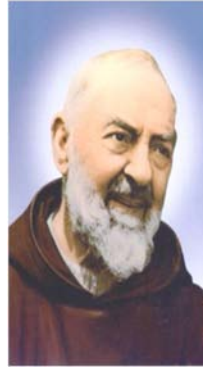
